



THIS IS HALLOWEEN!

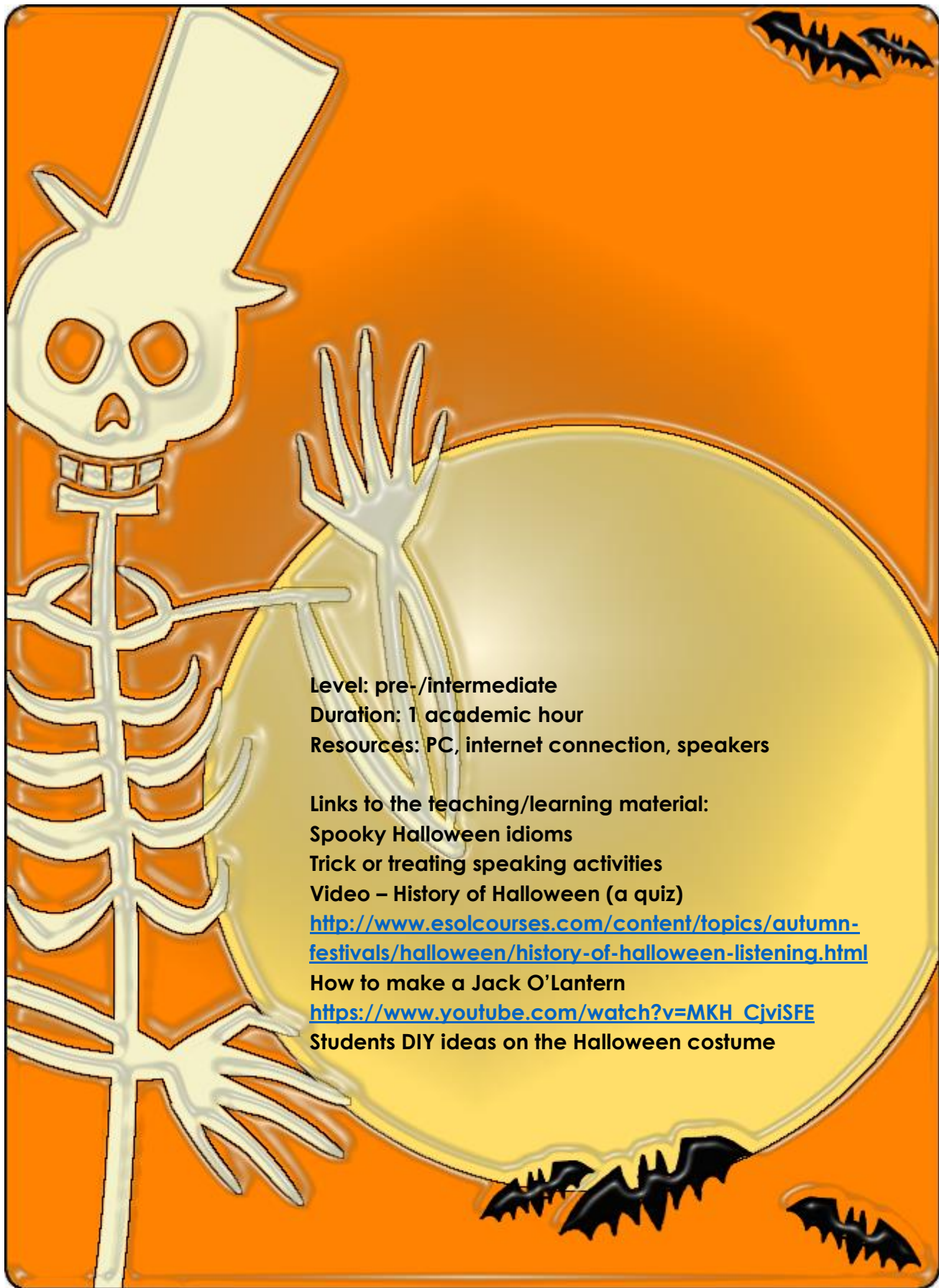
Goals:

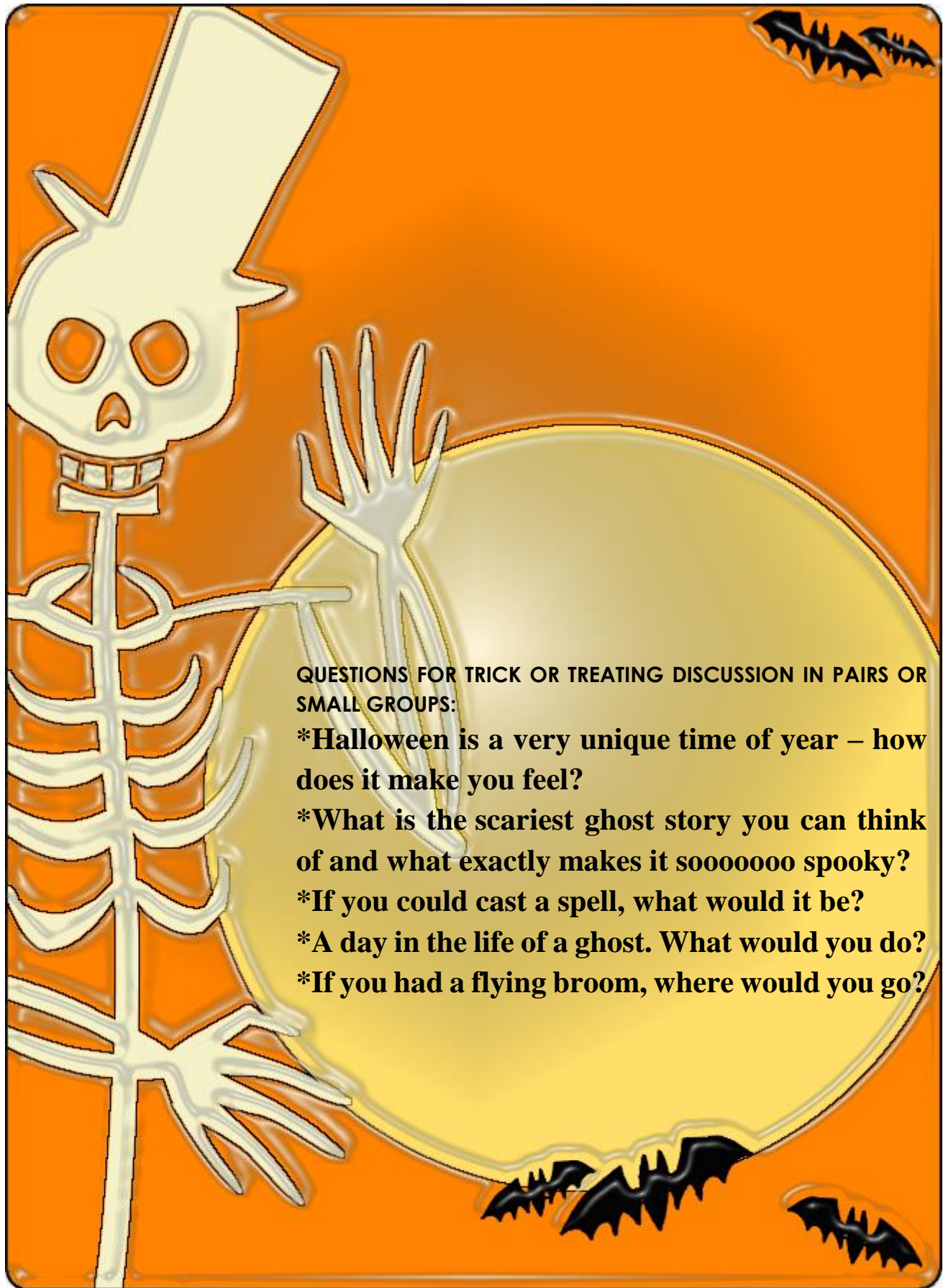
